### BERTHAGE 1

- Length: 183 metres (600 feet)
- Maximum Vessel Length Berthages 1 & 2: 50 metres (500 feet)
- Depth: 7.6 metres (25 feet)
- Deck Elevation: 2.5 metres (8 feet)
- Maximum Draft: Harbour channel 8 metres, harbour anchor 10 metres
- Turning Basin: 400 metres (1,300 feet)
- Tidal Range: 0.4 metres to 2.1 metres
- Pleasure Craft Dock: 50 metres available at tendering-in dock location

### BERTHAGE 2

- Length: 183 metres (600 feet)
- Depth: 7.6 metres (25 feet)
- Deck Elevation: 2.5 metres (8 feet)
